SERVICE TIPS Snake Oil in a Can

Now that it's hotter than blazes out there it's a good time to remind customers and technicians alike about the damage that a one-pound can of refrigerant can inflict on A/C components and service equipment.

Sold at auto parts stores and through the mail, many of these products aren't pure R-134a but a toxic hydrocarbon blend. Check the MSDS for details.

Most contain a PAG lubricant and leak sealer. If the oil type and viscosity don't match the compressor's original PAG oil, the manufacturer will analyze the oil and probably void the warranty if the compressor lunges. Sealant can plug TXVs and contaminate your service equipment.

If a system is losing charge, vehicle owners need to see a qualified A/C technician and find out why. Talk to your Red Dot Account Manager about refrigerant identifiers and other products from Yellow Jacket to help you protect your service equipment from a DIY charge-job.
